This term we have launched 'The Campaign to Get Greenholm Reading!' This campaign is to encourage pupils to enjoy reading at home and at school.

So far there has been a very positive response from pupils with certificates being given out to weekly 'Reading Champions' in each year group, favourite books being shared in class and key stage assemblies and certificates also being given out to pupils who have shown an excellent attitude to reading in class by the lunchtime supervisors.



The first week back after the holidays (week beginning 28.2.17) we will be having a 'Book Week'. Throughout the week, the children will be involved in a wide range of book and reading related activities.

Monday	Book Week Launch in assembly Fun and engaging reading related activities in class during the day.

Pupils bring book in to share with class. • KS2 book hunt AM • Whole school Assembly 2.30pm assembly - share costumes and reading/book related things done that day/week so far.
Wednesday	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Key Stage Assemblies - book quizzes. • KS2 - Books Into Bedtime Workshop (6-7) • Children come back to school in PJs to share favourite stories and play book related games in the dark! Parent reading workshop to run alongside this with lots of ideas and advice about how you can support your child with their reading
Thursday	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • KS1 parent workshop 2 PM in classes.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Parents invited to come into school to make a story sack with their class.
Friday	Children produce a piece of writing about their reading experiences that week. One piece of writing will be chosen from each class to share in assembly. KSI 'Where's Wally Hunt'

The main date you need to remember is Tuesday 28.2.17- Dress up day so get your needle and thread out! This is different to 'World Book Day' which is 2.3.17

KS2 will also get to visit Perry Common Library this week.
