IMPACT

Sports coaches, Lunchtime outside events and After school clubs

As a result of the variety of after school activities and sports events, many more pupils have access to sports clubs and physical activities which means that they are able to participate in competitive sports in a way that they may not be able to otherwise. In the last academic year the numbers of pupils who attended after school clubs at some point were 300. Some of the activities offered have been Gymnastics, multi-skills, fun team games, football, extreme frisbee, cricket, tag rugby and dance.

Playleader (Evolve)

The current play leader target specific pupils with low self-esteem to support within a specific year group, offering rewards and incentives. She leads outside play activities with these and others during playtimes and lunchtimes and offers two after school clubs, netball and dodgeball. As a result of her work the confidence in identified pupils has improved and the activities at lunchtime ensure that these pupils and others can channel their energy into something physical that is productive

Lunchtimes

As a result of offering lunchtime dance and dodge ball clubs in the hall an additional 100 pupils per week (25 per day) can attend a club and are increasing their physical wellbeing. Clubs run for half and pupils learn skills to support them in team games, physical fitness, co-ordination and flexibility as well as responding to and improving their reaction times.
